Charities Regulator receives action plan from board of Ataxia Ireland CLG

The Charities Regulator today received an action plan from the board of Ataxia Ireland CLG to address the recommendations of the Charities Regulator's inspectors' report into the charity.

Following publication of the inspectors' report on 27 July, the Charities Regulator wrote to the trustees of Ataxia Ireland CLG, giving them 21 days to provide the Charities Regulator with an action plan which addresses the inspectors' recommendations.

On 15 August the Board of Ataxia Ireland wrote to the Charities Regulator requesting a further fortnight to finalise their action plan. Due to the significant nature of some of the findings contained in the inspectors' report that the charity needs to address, the Charities Regulator agreed to the charity's request and extended the deadline to today (1 September).

The Charities Regulator received the action plan today. This plan is now being considered by the Charities Regulator to decide if the plan adequately addresses the inspectors' recommendations.
